## GENERAL TROUBLESHOOTING:

### HOW TO INSERT A SIM CARD

1. Use a #1 Phillips screwdriver to remove the SIM card cover.
2. Slide the primary SIM card in brass side down until it clicks into place.
3. If you are using a dual cellular setup, the secondary SIM will go into the lower slot, brass side up.
4. Once installed, you may re-attach the cover.

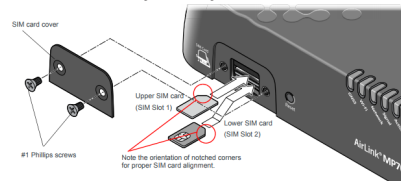


Figure 2-1: Installing the SIM Card

4. Replace the SIM card cover.

### LED BEHAVIOR

1. Use a #1 Phillips screwdriver to remove the SIM card cover.
2. Slide the SIM card in brass side up until it clicks into place.
3. If you are only using a single cellular plan, the SIM will go into slot A1
4. If you are using dual cellular plans, the SIMs will go into slot A1 and B1

GNSS	Solid Green	Satellite fix available
	Flashing Amber	No satellite fix available
	Off	
Wi-Fi	Solid Green	Wi-Fi enabled (any mode), and not connected to an access point
	Flashing Green	Transmitting/receiving over Wi-Fi while not connected to an access point
	Solid Amber	Wi-Fi connected to an access point (i.e. Network state is "Network Ready - Wi-Fi")
	Flashing Amber	Transmitting/receiving over Wi-Fi while connected to an access point
	Off	Wi-Fi is off
Network	Flashing Amber	Connecting to a network
	Flashing Green	Connected to WAN (over cellular, Wi-Fi, or Ethernet)
	Solid Green	Connected to VPN
	Off	No network connection
Signal		If the active WAN link is:
		• Cellular—Signal shown is for the cellular radio for that link.
		• Other (Wi-Fi, Ethernet, etc.)—Signal shown is for the strongest cellular radio.
	Solid Green	Good signal ( ≥85 dBm; equivalent to 4–5 bars)

1. Ensure that the vehicle is running.
2. Check the ignition and power fuses in the yellow fuse holders.
3. If the MP70 still won't boot, contact Keltek for service.

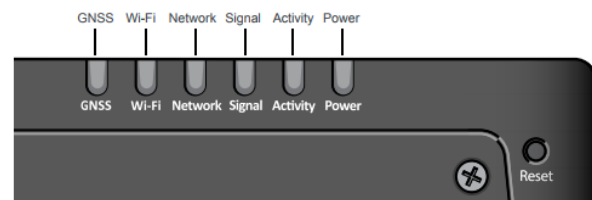


Figure 2-15: MG90 LED Status Indicators (front panel)
